The development and maintenance of the Museum’s extensive collection of artefacts, grounds and buildings is an ongoing process, requiring constant attention from our team of volunteer Museum specialists and tradespeople. Traditional fundraising methods, such as sausage sizzles at Bunnings, the Book Emporium and the Ladies handcraft stall, provide limited funds and need to be supplemented through grant funding applications. However, the current level of maintenance and restoration required for the new financial year at the Museum is expected to absorb most of our available funds.
